TO
REAL ESTATE EXCISE TAX AFFIDAVIT

That part of Lot 1 of Block "JJ" of Vineland, according to plat recorded in Book A of plats, page 14, in Asotin County, Washington, described as follows:

From the centerline of 13th Street and Highland Avenue, run West along the centerline of Highland Avenue a distance of 85 feet to the True Point of Beginning; thence North parallel to the centerline of 13th Street a distance of 151 feet to a point; thence West parallel to the centerline of Highland a distance of 76.5 feet to a point; thence South parallel to the centerline of 13th Street a distance of 151 feet to a point on the centerline of Highland Avenue; thence East on the centerline of Highland Avenue a distance of 76.5 feet to the True Point of Beginning. EXCEPTING the area within the platted right-of-way of Highland Avenue.

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
